



You are invited to the All Town Celebration



Please **ATTEND.... it's FREE....** and very **SPECIAL**

on **Sunday April 17, 2011** at the **FLAGLER MUSEUM**

Parade - Gather at the Recreation Center at 6 p.m. and join the promenade to the Flagler Museum – march along with students, service organizations, local residents, musicians and local heroes – or watch the antique cars carrying local officials and dignitaries along the Coconut Row parade route heading north ending at the Poinciana Chapel at 7 p.m.

Celebration - Meet friends and neighbors on the front mall of the Flagler Museum at 6 p.m. or after the parade. There will be food concession stands offering boxed meals and cold bottled water for \$5. Publix Supermarket will give birthday cupcakes to the first 3,000 visitors. Limited open seating is provided on a first come basis and residents are encouraged to bring blankets for open seating on the lawn. No alcohol, open coolers or private lawn chairs are permitted in the celebration area.

Ceremony - Residents will witness the Mayor, Town Council and other dignitaries and recognize the centennial milestone together in this “All Town Celebration” which includes musical entertainment, a specially produced film of local personalities, an extraordinary sound and light show utilizing the latest computer-generated visual effects and graphics projected on to the Flagler Museum (The show can only be viewed from the front mall of the Museum). The ceremony and begins at 8:00pm and concludes at 9:00pm.



- **Coconut Row will be closed between Royal Palm Way and Royal Poinciana Way - between 5:00pm and 11:00pm.**
- **Home owners may cross police barricades with identification.**



- **There is very limited public parking near the event site. Residents are encouraged to walk or ride their bikes to the celebration. Out of town guests should park in downtown West Palm Beach public parking garages and walk across the bridge.**
- **Major donors with a valet parking pass will be permitted to access the Flagler Museum through the police check point at Royal Poinciana Way and Coconut Row.**
- **Limited preferred parking is available with a general parking pass until 7:00pm at the Royal Poinciana Way and Coconut Row police checkpoint.**

Limited Group Transportation is Provided as Follows:

- **To and From the South:** Buses will pick up residents at Phipps Ocean Park & Old Bridge Park at 5:00pm, 5:15pm, 5:30pm, 6:00pm, 6:15pm, 6:30pm, & 7:00pm at both locations. Group transportation is limited to the first 275 people at each location. Busses will return to the same locations in rotation starting at 9:15pm.
- **To and From the North:** Molly's Trolleys will pick up residents along North Ocean Blvd at the following intersections in 20 minute intervals starting at 5:00pm – La Puerta Way, Orange Grove Road, Eden Ave, The Beach Club Parking Lot, Cherry Lane, Tangier Ave and Wells Road. Group transportation is limited to the first 125 people at each location. Residents are cautioned to wear reflective clothing, use flash lights and take care when waiting for the trolleys. Trolleys will return to the same locations in rotation starting at 9:15pm.
